LABORATORY NOTEBOOK CHECK LIST

Lab notebooks will be graded. They must include the following:

- An <u>up-to-date</u> table of contents.
- Notes in Ink.
- Your name and the date on every page.
- Names of partners on the first page for each day.
- File names for any data stored on computers.
- Equipment used (name, brand, identifying number).
- Cartoon/drawings of any special setups.
- Plan/procedure (If following procedure provided to you just reference the handout and note any modifications. For example, "followed procedures in <u>Line Spectra</u> and <u>Significant Digits Handout</u> by J. Gutow 2008, with the following modifications...").
- All observations.
- All data to the correct number of significant digits and with correct units.
- All calculations with the correct number of significant digits and with correct units.
- Cross out changes with a single line. Do not erase.
- Large blank spaces should be X'ed out.
- A copy of all graphes or data tables generated by computer must be secured to the notebook (tape or staple) and trimmed to fit inside.
